- How to install and locate water meters (introduction to meter validation certification requirements)
- Irrigation scheduling concepts (CIAg RPL Unit: AHCIRG403A)
- Scheduling irrigation diary training (CIAg RPL Unit: AHCIRG408A)
- Calculating irrigation system capacity (CIAg RPL Unit: AHCIRG501A)
